
Spring/Summer 2023 Survey Key Findings: New York City



Communities Speak aims to increase the diversity and influence of community voices in policymaking by developing data-driven dialogue between community leaders, constituents, and governments. Data is collected during biannual needs assessment surveys directed at traditionally underserved communities.



Access and Affordability About 1 in 4 New Yorkers reported difficulty affording_healthcare

About 1 in 4 New Yorkers reported difficulty accessing healthcare

Healthcare Affordability for Seniors

37.5% of <u>households with seniors</u>* in NYC reported difficulty affording healthcare

*Households with seniors are defined as respondents who reported people aged 65+ in their household.





5 in 10 <u>above median income</u> New Yorkers reported experiencing above average stress levels




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


Public Safety



*Housing insecurity is defined as difficulty paying rent/mortgage and/or difficulty accessing housing.

**Severe housing insecurity is defined as having at least two of the following indicators: difficulty paying rent/mortgage and/or difficulty accessing housing and/or experienced difficulty finding housing and/or experienced eviction or threat of eviction.



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
