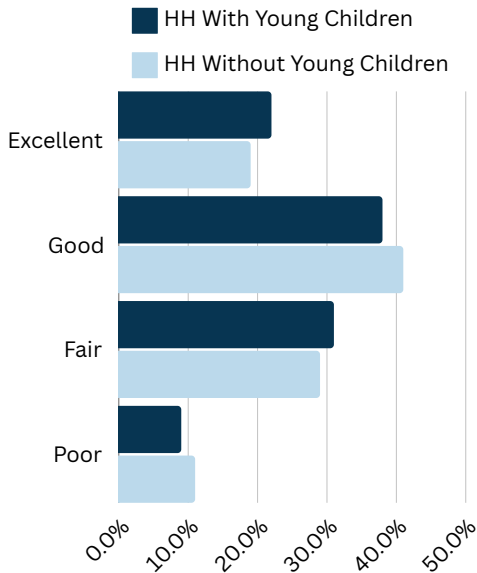
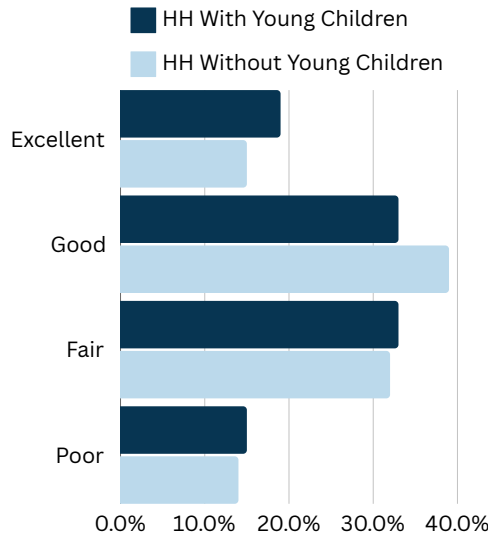

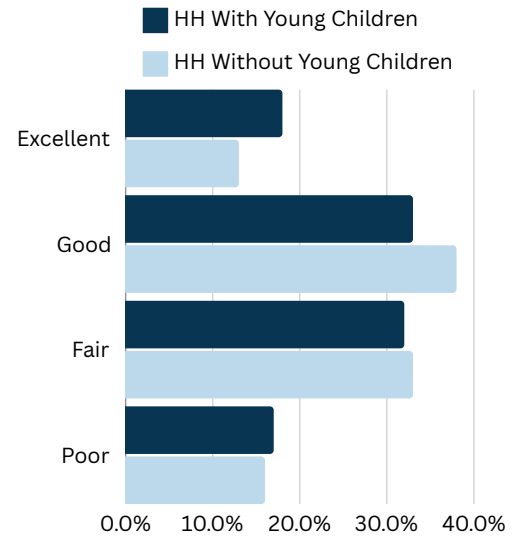

Fewer than 1 in 5 households with young children reported fearing or experiencing eviction

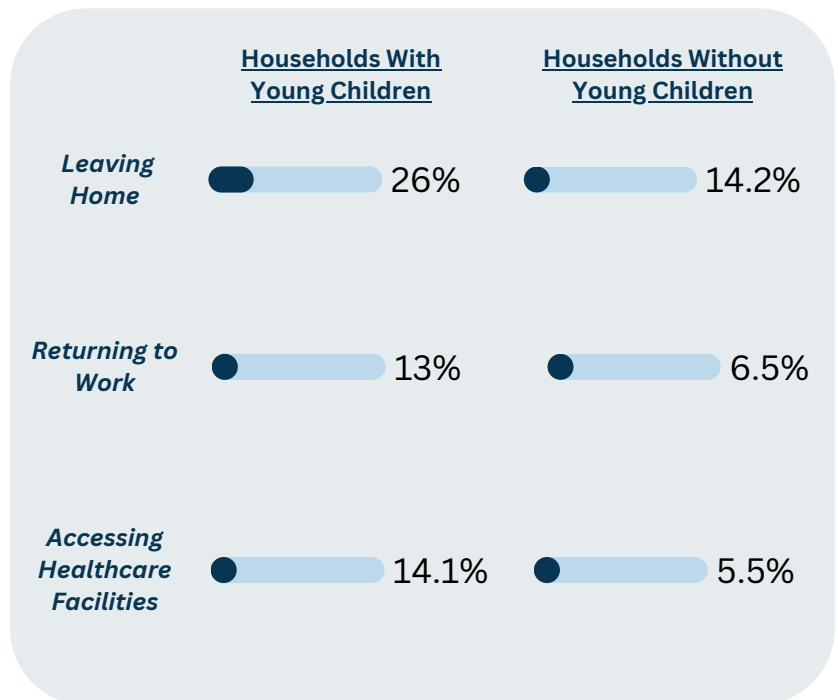


Almost 1 in 4 households with young children reported difficulty affording healthcare

Households With Young Children Avoided Routine Activities at a High Rate Due to Crime and Safety Concerns



*Severe food insecurity is defined as having at least two of the following indicators: difficulty affording food and/or difficulty accessing food and/or worried about running out of food and/or ran out of food or was unable to find food.
